


NEW SOCIAL TENNIS FOR WOMEN

Court hire vs Membership. Court hire costs \$15 per hour. No other rights or benefits except for insurance at the time of the court hire. An adult social membership is \$140 per year, equivalent to approx 10 court 1hour court hires per year. Membership also gives you access to all 9 courts, not just the synthetic grass courts. Membership also includes voting rights, cheaper social competition fees, entry to club social events, insurance coverage and club championship entry.
